- 1943 -Born in December
- 1967 Graduated from Keio University in Tokyo with a Master of Law
- 1967 Employed by Yahagi Construction Company at the golf course building division
- 1970 -Associated with Peter Thomson, Australian pro-golfer, five times British Open winner as a Far East Asia colleague.
- 1973 -Partnered with Peter Thomson's Golf Course Architect Company in Melbourne to participate in designing / building more than 15 golf courses not only in Japan but also in Asia.
- 1978 -Resigned Yahagi Construction Company to succeeded to the family business, Marumi Corporation
- 1983 Established Ladies Asia Golf Circuit (LAGC) as a founder
- 1987 -Became a director of Kosaido Company and developed Kosaido Ladies Asia Golf Circuit under the auspices of Asia Pacific Golf Confederation (APGC) and was supported by the R&A St Andrews.
- 1993 -Became a director of Camden Lakeside Country Club in Sydney
- 2000 -Passed the exam of the Referee School of R&A St. Andrews
- 2005 -The Sponsorship by Kosaido Company terminated and re-launched Ladies Asian Golf Tour (LAGT) registered in Hong Kong and was appointed as the Director & the Chief Commissioner
- 2006 -Took over the management of Camden Lakeside Country Club in Sydney as the President
- 2007 -Became the President & Chief Commissioner of Ladies Asian Golf Tour of which headquarters was moved to Japan from Hong Kong
- 2010 -Sold Camden Lakeside Country Club in Sydney and retired from the family business, Marumi Corporation
- 2012 -LAGT became a member of International Golf Federation PGA Tour and was independent from APGC and R&A
- 2018 -Associated colleague, Peter Thomson died in June, and the partnership accordingly vanished
- 2019 -To now as the Chairman of LAGT
